**Midwest Sport and Entertainment School Waiver Release**

My child has been offered the opportunity to wear protective gear. Helmets, wrist guards, knee pads, and elbow pads are all required.

I realize that protective gear is designed to reduce the risk of injury, but will not prevent all injuries: for example, a helmet will not prevent all head injuries. There is no guarantee of safety.

To further reduce the risk of injury, I acknowledge that my child should skate in control and within his or her abilities. I understand and acknowledge that increasing speed rapidly could cause a skater to lose control, fall, or be injured.

I understand and acknowledge that the brake on an in-line skate is designed to stop a skater gradually. Highest P.E. skating will only be done indoors on a gym floor. I further understand that there are risks involved with in-line skating. Some of these risks can include falls and contact with other skaters. I freely assume these risks and release Rollerblade, Inc., Lifetime Sports, Inc. and their respective employees and agents from any liability claim or suit arising from use of skates, protective gear, or equipment. This would include any claims of negligence by any of these parties released above. I have read and agree to all statements included herein, and by my signature agree to all statements herein.
